

# **MCHE Witnesses to the Holocaust Archive**

The MCHÉ Witnesses to the Holocaust Archive features the testimonies of dozens of local survivors and other eyewitnesses to the Holocaust. This collection is available in multiple formats, including the following:

- unedited video testimonies available for viewing in the MCHÉ Resource Center. These testimonies average 2 hours in length with some lasting as long as 3 hours.
- condensed video testimonies available for free loan from the MCHÉ Resource Center and appropriate for classroom use.

## **FOR CLASSROOM USE:**

*Recently edited for classroom use, these video testimonies tie to the Core Concepts in Holocaust Education as recommended by MCHÉ. These testimonies were specifically edited for 7-12<sup>th</sup> grade classroom use and run in length from 20-45 minutes. DVDs are organized into thematic chapters for easy reference and classroom instruction. This accompanying curriculum includes suggested teaching approaches, specific classroom exercises and historical content to enhance these programs.*

- unedited audio testimonies available for use in the MCHÉ Resource Center.
